In May 2026, the partnership between Lifewater Canada and STADA Kenya came to an end. STADA had been one of three implementing partners for Lifewater Canada in Kenya since 2021. While we are proud of the work that has been done and the people that have benefitted through this partnership in several key areas of WASH programming, a departure of priorities and practice led to the partnership no longer aligning with Lifewater Canada's mission and values.

Lifewater Canada maintains high expectations for both performance and accountability. We require annual reports, project documentation, government compliance, and audits, as part of our responsibility to you. Both before and during my visit with STADA in January 2026, we spent time working on these requirements with hope to get this partnership back on track. We continued to work with STADA until the partnership was dissolved at their request.

In May 2026 Lifewater Canada Donor funded equipment, (including vehicles, drilling rigs, and pump inventory), was secured and redeployed with our other two existing Kenyan partners and STADA was paid in full its final installment.

Lifewater Canada's Kenya operations will continue through partnerships with Lifewater Rescue Kenya and The Lifewater Kenya. We will not be looking to form any new teams or partnerships in Kenya in the foreseeable future. Lifewater Canada's remaining partnerships in Kenya, as well as those in Liberia, Nigeria, and Haiti are outstanding, providing help and hope through safe and accessible water, sanitation, and hygiene.

Our annual report will be released in the near future to share more details of our ongoing work.
